- ◆ Three of each fruit entered must be submitted by the entrant.
- ◆ Place fruit in one paper bag.
- ◆ The bag must be clearly labeled with entrant's name, address and phone number, as well as the type of fruit.
- ◆ Citrus entries will be accepted at the Fort Bend County Extension Annex, 1402 Band Road, Suite 100, Rosenberg, Texas. The entry deadline is 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 2, 2009.

## 2009 Fort Bend County Citrus Show

### RULES

1. Judges' decisions are final.
2. Show management reserves the right to make changes and additions to the rules.
3. There is no entry fee, however all entries become property of the show.
4. Judges reserve the right to cut fruit for the purpose of judging.
5. Each entry must consist of 3 of the same variety of fruit. Buttons (stems) must be intact and loosely clipped. Fruit should be clean, natural color, unwaxed and of uniform size.
6. Exhibitors may enter as many varieties as desired but only one entry for each variety per exhibitor is allowed.
7. Place entry in paper bag or Ziploc bag with a card stapled to outside listing:
  - Name, address, phone number, type of fruit and variety.
  - If variety is not known, mark card as Variety Unknown. The entry will be identified at the show.

### TIPS FOR PREPARING ENTRIES

1. Avoid fruit obviously affected by insect damage or disease.
2. Avoid Mixed samples. Good entries may be disqualified due to several varieties or types being placed in one sample bag.
3. Fruit should be clean, but not polished.
